

# Sweden

- Reference:** SWE-01 "International Youth Sailing Camp"
- Offer:** The Rotary Clubs of Karlshamn and Karlshamn-Morrum and the Karlshamn Sailing Society invite you to their sailing camp.
- Accommodation:** Hosting by Rotary families.
- Dates:** Sunday 2nd August to Wednesday 12th August 2009
- Age Group and Gender:** 1M or 1F aged 16 to 18 at the start of the camp.
- Cost:** Return travel to Ronneby airport or to Karlshamn railway station plus personal spending money and insurance. Ronneby airport is served by regular flights from Stockholm Arlanda. Also there is a direct rail connection from Copenhagen to Karlshamn, journey time approximately 2.5 hours.
- Insurance and Official papers:** You will require insurance against illness, accident, third party claims and luggage loss. You should be able to provide evidence of insurance to the organisers.
- Programme:** Training and sailing in small keelboats in sheltered waters, including one overnight stay on an island in the archipelago. Canoe paddling and other leisure activities, community visits and participation in Rotary meetings. A detailed program for the camp will be sent directly to the participants. **NOTE:** Sailing experience is not necessary, but participants must be good swimmers.
